QuimeraRR AEDC racer looking for fresh livery in all-electric drift contest

Doesn't that car look a little bit naked?

The vehicle in question is the QuimeraRR AEDC, which is being called "the world's first all-electric car purpose-built for drifting" by the team behind the car, Quimera Responsible Racing and Electric K1 founder Alex Letteriello. To gussy up the AEDC, QuimeraRR has launched a design competition that is looking for a "contemporary livery designed to showcase its unique attributes."

The AEDC will be used in a new, worldwide "non-fossil fuel-based" motorsport championship that will start in 2013. Quimera, the International Motor Sport Association and the American Le Mans Series are working together on the project for which the AEDC will be the standard-bearer. Eleven judges, including IMSA and ALMS president Scott Atherton and Formula Drift co-founder Jim Liaw, will look over the livery contest submissions, awarding the winner tickets to the car's October unveiling at the Toyota Speedway in Irwindale, CA and \$5,000. The AEDC is a successor to Quimera's all-sexy, all-electric [AEGT01](#), which you can read about [here](#), bonus video included. In January 2012, Quimera [announced the new racing series](#), saying that vehicles in the drifting class could be "up to 250kW" and the series will "comply with all sanctioned safety regulations." Just so we're clear on that.
